in the November 14, 1965 attack, the Bureau desired to be expeditiously advised whether the facts concerning this attack constitute a violation of neutrality statutes and if so, whether prosecution is contemplated. The Department was advised that the Bureau was holding further investigation of this matter in abeyance pending their reply.

In view of the information furnished by Dr. SANTIAGO ALVAREZ that he had initially participated in discussions with MIGUEL IZA and HERMINIO DIAZ concerning a possible operation against Cuba but later withdrew from these plans, as well as the information that is son, SANTIAGO ALVAREZ, JR., was not involved, it is not believed that additional investigation of this matter as related to the MRR, is warranted.
