Mrs. MARIE MUCHMORE, 2980 Randy Lane, Farmers Branch, Dallas, Texas, who is employed by Justin McCarty Dress Manufacturers, 707 Young Street, Dallas, advised that on November 22, 1963, she and five other employees from the company, including one WILMA BOND, went to observe the Presidential parade. advised that they stood on Main and Houston Streets. As the parade passed by there she heard the first shot but from where they were standing could not observe where the shot came from. She said she panicked after this shot and ran back to the office, later becoming deathly sick over the incident when learning of the President's death. She said she had a movie camera with her at the time and WILMA BOND had a box type camera but she advised that she did not obtain any photographs of the assassination scene. She said that WILMA BOND had some of her photographs developed but they were just of the crowd and the caravan and from where they were standing, as previously mentioned, did not get any pictures of the assassination.

Mrs. MUCHMORE advised she returned to Ardmore, Oklahoma, for the holidays and told her family, who reported it to the FBI. She said she did not think she could be of any further assistance because she did not even know the building where the shots came from and friends of hers had to point it out to her.
