He also knows that she was interested in improving her Russian speaking ability and had advised him, prior to November 22, 1963, that the reason she had MARINA OSWALD residing with her was because MARINA OSWALD needed help and was a good companion. Also that she, Mrs. PAINE, wanted to improve her ability to speak the Russian language by conversing with MARINA OSWALD.

Mr. KRYSTINIK advised that RUTH PAINE felt that LEE HARVEY OSWALD was not properly taking care of his wife and children.

Mr. KRYSTINIK said his contact with RUTH PAINE arises by virtue of his association with her husband, MICHAEL PAINE, a fellow employee at the Bell Helicopter Company at Hurst, Texas (Fort Worth).
