JAMES EARL JARMAN, Jr., also known as "JUNIOR", advised that ~~he resides at 3942 Atlanta~~ in Dallas, Texas and is employed as a checker at the Texas School Book Depository (TSBD) in Dallas. He said that he and HAROLD "HANK" NORMAN and BONNIE RAY WILLIAMS were all employed at the TSBD at Dallas, Texas on November 21, 1963. He said that he and the other two boys ate lunch on the first floor around 12:00 noon on November 22, 1963, and shortly afterwards went to the fifth floor, about 12:25 P.M., on the west elevator in the building in order to watch the Presidential parade. He said they stayed there until they heard the sound of shots; then they went downstairs. He said RAY and NORMAN were with him all the time he was on the first floor and they did not see LEE HARVEY OSWALD at any time between 12:00 noon until they returned to the first floor after the shooting.

JARMAN advised that HAROLD NORMAN is no longer employed at the TSBD, but he thinks he still resides at 4858 Beulah.
