JAMES JARMAN, 3942 Atlanta, advised that he is currently employed with the Texas School Book Depository (TSBD), 411 Elm Street, Dallas, Texas, and that he knew LEE HARVEY OSWALD only casually through their mutual employment with TSBD. JARMAN advised that he could not recall what type of clothing OSWALD was wearing on November 22, 1963, but that OSWALD usually worked in a white tee-shirt. He stated there was a "dressing room" on the first floor of the TSBD where the employees could change their clothing or leave their shirts when they commenced work or during working hours. He said that when OSWALD worked in a tee-shirt, OSWALD usually had a regular shirt in the dressing room.

JARMAN was shown a rust brown sport shirt with a hole in the right sleeve at the elbow, which, according to the arresting officers, was being worn by OSWALD at the time of his arrest on November 22, 1963. JARMAN stated that the above-described shirt was vaguely familiar, but he could not recall if this shirt was worn by OSWALD on November 22, 1963.
