Mr. H. S. AIKEN, Bookkeeper, Texas School Book Depository, at the instructions of Mr. ROY TRULY, made available the official payroll records for the Texas School Book Depository, which records specifically covered employment of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

These records reflected that OSWALD first worked for this company on October 16, 1963, and worked continuously at 8 hours per day, from October 16 through November 22, 1963, without missing any day's work. During this period of time he was off only on Saturdays, Sundays, and November 11, 1963, which was a company holiday.

Verifax copies were made of these payroll records and are being retained in the files of the Dallas Division.
